

SHORT TERM MISSION OPPORTUNITY AT SEA, Westminster CAMBODIA

1. Positions: English Instructors
2. Dates:
 - SEA begins the 3rd or 4th Monday of June every year and lasts for four weeks. You need to confirm the dates with the school for the year you plan to serve.
 - You are to schedule to arrive at School at least a half week earlier than the program starts and to depart the school after the program ends.
3. Purpose: To outreach young men and women in Cambodia through a four-week intensive ESL program
4. Specific Responsibilities and Others:
 - Responsibilities: Prepare for and conduct ESL instruction for four weeks; Evaluate the student and keep the record of the student's performance; Support the other instructors and staff when needed.
 - Textbooks, Teacher's Manuals, Supplies, and Instructional Aides: The school provides with ESL textbooks, activity books, and the manual for English Instructors; Instructional Aides may be assigned to assist for various jobs.
5. Qualifications:
 - If you are a seminarian with reformed and Presbyterian background, you are preferred for the position.
 - You must be a mature Christian committed to serving the Lord Jesus Christ.
 - You should be willing to share your Christian faith with others.
 - You must live and worship with all others in the community while serving, building up relationships with them by staying open and flexible to the mores around you.
6. Travel and Financial Information:
 - Room and Board: WTCS provides you with room and board while you do your mission service in Cambodia, and airport transportations when you arrive and depart.
 - Your Responsibility:
 - 1) Finances: You need to raise fund for your airfare, and your personal and travel expenses. Your airfare varies depending on your departing place.
 - 2) Travel Immunization: Check with the Centers for Disease Control (www.cdc.gov) for updated information regarding the travel destination.
 - 3) Passport: If you do not have a passport, you must begin the application procedures as early enough as possible. Please check www.travel.state.gov. You need to renew your passport if it expires within six months.
 - 4) Entrance VISA: You can get your visa at the Phnom Penh airport upon your arrival, and you need to prepare a passport photo for your visa and some cash for it (The current service fee is \$30 for single for tourist, \$35 for single business as of 2019.)
